

New Senior Pastor at First UMC Arrives July 1

Terry Neeley, chair of Staff Parish Relations Committee, announced Sunday that Rev. Brett DeHart will be the new senior pastor of First United Methodist Church, Sarasota, as Dr. Sam Wright retires. The son of two Floridians and a graduate of Florida State University, Rev. DeHart is thrilled to return to Florida to serve FUMC starting July 1.

He has been a pastor in the North Georgia Conference for 21 years and a national leader in Fresh Expressions. Churches he has pastored have successfully launched and sustained Messy Church, Recovery Church, and Dinner Church. Rev. DeHart was recognized with the Harry Denman Evangelism Award in 2023.

Before entering the ministry, he was a sportscaster for six years and in business for ten years. He has a Bachelor of Science in Communications and a Master of Divinity from Emory's Candler School of Theology. Brett and wife Cindy (sweethearts since high school) have been married for 32 years and have two children in their 20s, Samantha (clinical dietician) and Spencer (pilot).
