Our District Superintendent Rev. Dr. Debbie Allen has authorized and will preside at a Church Conference of First United Methodist Church, Sarasota, on Wednesday, May 29, at 6 p.m. in the Sanctuary.

The purpose of the church conference is to consider approving the sale of the green space along the west side of Mira Mar Court, which includes the ECC playground, to Seaward Development for \$7.5 million. A new playground will be constructed using part of our Mira Mar parking lot. The lost parking spaces will be replaced by parking spaces in the new parking garage built by Seaward on Mira Mar Court.

All members of First UMC, Sarasota, are welcome and have a right to vote at this Church Conference.

## **News from Ukraine**



From FUMC member Andy Roman:

The sun rises on a damp morning in central Ukraine as Pastor Sergey and team prepare for a long day's work of clearing rubble and leveling the ground for a new "hope home." Last week the village of Krasylivka, near Kyiv, was bombed. A woman whose home was destroyed is recovering in the hospital. Sergey has already sprung into action so she will have a cozy tiny house.

If only this were an unusual story. Unfortunately, her story is too familiar to Sergey and the Ukrainians. By sunset, there is a new home where the rubble was. This is the 293<sup>rd</sup> home Sergey and team have built since the beginning of the war, changing the lives of countless people doing God's work.

Pastor Sergey is also overseeing the building of a second church in Moshchun to house refugees, facilitate food distribution, and for worship services. These missions are only possible by the continued support of generous congregations such as First United Methodist Church of Sarasota. Sergey and team, plus the refugees, thank YOU for all you have done. The impact of your loving care is felt every day. Praise God!
